

**Australian Green & Gold Limited - Disclosure Notice to Growers in the Brooklyn Park Olive Groves MIS, Stage 1 to Stage 4 extension.**

November 11<sup>th</sup> 2009

Dear Growers,

***Re : Your olive grove / s in the Brooklyn Park Olive Groves Managed Investment Scheme***

I am writing to inform you of severe weather events that occurred in late September 2009 that farm management believe may negatively impact the yields achievable from the scheduled 2010 harvest. Three severe dust storms (*these storms affected the majority of central and eastern Australia*), in late September has resulted in preventing the flowers (or buds) on the trees from forming into fruit. The dust prevented pollination (or fertilisation of the flowers) and hence fruit set.

Farm management has advised the Board that they anticipate these weather events will cause a decline in yield for the 2010 harvest. Exact data on yield projections for the 2010 harvest cannot be provided at this time, however this information will be available closer to the time of harvest around April and May 2010.

This event whilst unfortunate, is an agricultural risk that may or may not occur on a seasonal basis. The directors and management do not consider this occurrence as 'normal seasonal conditions' for the Inglewood area.

The management and directors have been pleased with the past yields achieved from harvests in the 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008 season, which indicate that management yields projected for future years are achievable.
